It's widely used in Fiber Amplifier System, Fiber Optic Sensor and Testing System field. High Power version is also available upon request.

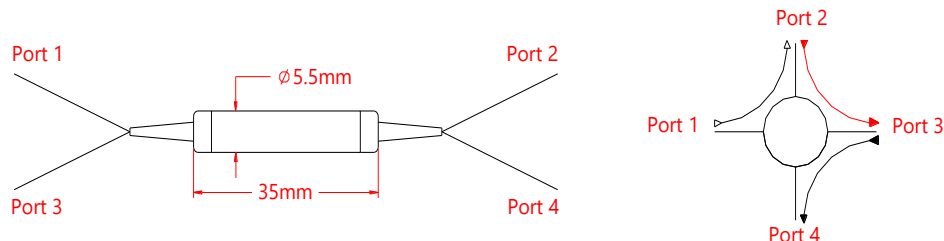
